It is our purpose to provide opportunities for your child to grow in their knowledge and understanding of who God is through His Word, the Bible.

All of the programs we provide are purposeful and useful for your child's spiritual formation.

TeamKID:

TeamKID is a unique blend of activity, interactive learning and Bible memory opportunities. Each week your child will learn biblical truths that can be immediately applied to their life. This mid-week Bible study will prove to be an important part of your child's busy week.

Wednesday at 6:30pm for Babies—6th Grade

Around the World:

Preschoolers will have a blast as they travel Around the World learning about God's love for them and for others. Preschoolers will be introduced to missionaries who tell people about Jesus. They will also learn about different cultures through taste, hands on activities, dress up and games.

Sunday at 6:00pm for Babies—Pre-K

Children's Choir:

Children's Choir is designed to allow your child to grow in their understanding of worship as well as to provide opportunities for leadership. Discussion and activities are used to teach the Biblical truths found in each song.

Sunday at 5:30pm for Kinder—6th Grade

Sunday Worship:

It is important for your child to be a part of the Worship Service each Sunday. By attending worship, your child can learn the importance of worshiping God as they join the church in singing, praying, giving, reading the Bible and learning as the pastor speaks. Worship is a special time to be with family and friends who love God. By attending church children will develop positive feelings of belonging, loving, giving and sharing.

Extended Teaching Class (ETC):

In ETC, all preschoolers discover more about their Sunday School lesson through learning centers and activities. ETC can also stand alone so that preschoolers who did not attend SS can learn the Biblical truths.

Children's Church Blowout:

All children K-6th grade meet together for children's church to spend time worshiping and discovering why church is so important.

Sunday School:

Sunday School is a vital part of your child's journey in Bible knowledge and application as well as Bible Skills. Each age group, from babies – 6th grade, has specific goals related to Bible skills such as knowing the books of the Bible, being able to find passages, being able to quote specific verses, and establishing a discipline of daily reading. Your child's Sunday School teacher can tell you more about specific goals for your child's class.

Let's Partner Together:

Set the stage for your child's church experience. Encourage your child to carry and use his own Bible. Stay informed about what your child is learning. Ask your child questions about the lesson they learned. Take your child to the restroom and for a drink of water before class starts.

When attending the worship service, lead your child to participate by greeting and shaking hands, singing the words on the screen, finding the passage of scripture and following along, listening to the sermon, testimonies and announcements. He can give an offering and pass the offering plate. Your child can observe and follow the example of his family and other worshipers. He can complete the activity pages that are provided while listening.
